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NOTES TO APPLICANTS

1. This form is to facilitate applicants of PolyU-SPEED award degree programmes to submit their application for a change of programme choice(s) during the admission period. For current students who wish to apply for transfer of study, please fill in **Form CAR 22**.
2. The duly completed application form should be submitted to the CPCE Academic Registry via email to spadmission@speed-polyu.edu.hk **one month before the programme commencement at the latest**.
3. Each applicant is normally allowed to apply for a change of programme choice(s) **ONCE** only. Applicants should take deliberate consideration before submission of this application.
4. The maximum number of programme choices for an applicant is **4**. However, if you have already had a study offer from SPEED and would like to apply for a change of your programme choice(s), the number of programmes that you can change/ add is up to **3**, as the original programme offered to you has already occupied one of your four choices.
5. Further to Note 4 above, your status of registration/ offer of the original programme will be updated as “withdrawn”/ “decline offer” as appropriate at the time when your application is processed.
6. Your application for a change of programme choice(s) will be reflected on the SPEED Online Application for Admission (OAA) system **normally within 10 working days**, upon receipt of a complete application.
7. Offering of a study place depends on the applicant’s suitability for the newly selected programme(s) and the availability of study places. Additional interviews and/or written tests may be required for the newly selected programme(s).
8. For non-local applicants who are offered a place and subsequently registered in any of the newly selected programme(s), the CPCE Academic Registry will inform the HKSAR Immigration Department accordingly.
9. The information given in this form will only be used for processing this application and/ or statistics purposes.
